## Barton to Highlight Spring Banquet

*Popular Historian, Author, Triggers Advance Reservations*

Even before formal invitations to previous attendees and donors were in the mail, table sales for CCV's 26th Annual Partnership Banquet were brisk.

Jerry Lyon, CCV's Vice-president of Operations and the event's coordinator, was not surprised.

"With David Barton as keynote speaker we're expecting a sell-out," Lyon explained. "It's first come, first served, and folks didn't want to miss out."

In the fall of last year, CCV sponsored a seven-city patriotic tour featuring Barton, an internationally renowned American historian, Christian author and founder of WallBuilders. Throughout the three-day tour, he spoke to standing-room-only audiences.

During the tour CCV received numerous requests to bring David back to Ohio at the first opportunity.

"We had not yet engaged a speaker to deliver the keynote address at our Partnership Banquet," said Lyon, "so Barton was a natural choice. But Barton speaks to over 400 groups annually. We made our request, but were doubtful that he would be available. When we received our confirmation, we were elated."

The choice of Barton was more than a response to popular demand.

"Underlying all of David Barton's work is the desire to see this

nation returned to its uniquely Christian moral foundation," Lyon expounds. "That is the same theme that underlies CCV's mission and work. It is a message that today is more critical than ever – critical to the very survival of our nation. And no one delivers that message more convincingly, or in a more constructive and encouraging tone, than David."

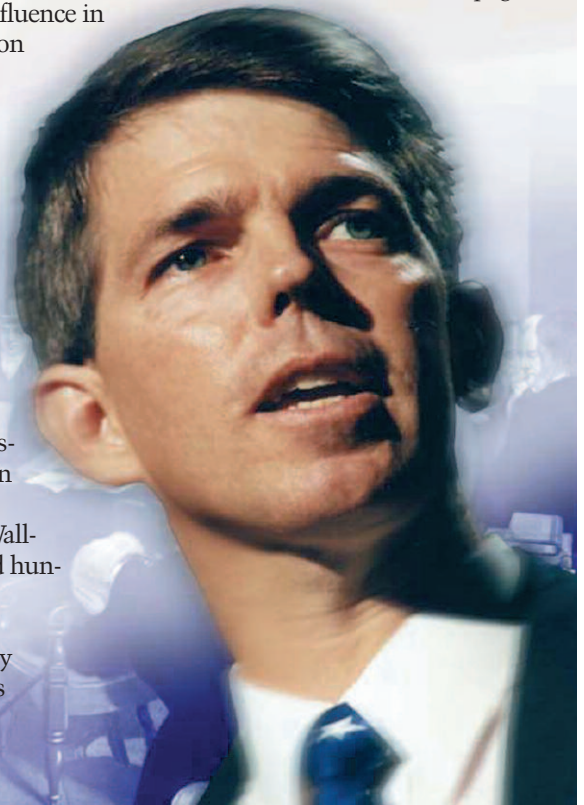
Barton founded WallBuilders in 1989. The organization's three-fold goal mirrors CCV's mission statement. That goal is to exert a direct and positive influence in government, education and the family by (1) educating the nation concerning the Christian foundation of our nation; (2) providing information to federal, state and local officials as they develop public policies that reflect Biblical values; and (3) encouraging Christians to be involved in the civic arena.

Over the years, WallBuilders has acquired hundreds of original documents, many of them hand-written by founding fathers. It is primarily through those original

manuscripts that WallBuilders has been able to document the rich religious and moral history of America as well as to establish the original intent undergirding America's foundation documents. A number of those original manuscripts will be on display prior to the banquet.

Also on display – and available for purchase – will be WallBuilder's own extensive store of educational and motivational books, CDs and videos.

# H.R.1: Stimulus for an Anti-family Agenda

*Fear, Haste, Closed Doors Replace Hope, Change and Transparency*

At first glance, addressing economic legislation may appear to be a departure from CCV's mission.

It really is not.

CCV is about families. Specifically, about upholding and protecting the uniquely Christian family values and freedoms that are foundational to America's past, and critical to America's future survival.

On so many levels, the so-called "economic stimulus package" passed by both houses of the U.S. Congress and signed into law by President Obama on February 17 represents a direct attack on those values and freedoms. It is not only within our mission, indeed, it is our solemn duty to brace the families of Ohio for its catastrophic impact.

Although economists and political analysts have found many ways to slice and dice President Obama's massive, signature spending bill, for our analysis most



provisions can be placed into one of two basic categories: those specifically designed to advance the President's anti-family social policy; and those that simply represent a ramping up of the moneyed

pork-barreling and payoffs that have characterized Washington politics for years, elimination of which was the primary theme of Obama's presidential campaign.

## Direct Anti-Family Funding

Even the liberal *New York Times* admitted – gleefully – that much of the so-called stimulus package is funding for the president's social re-engineering programs. The paper's January 28 headline bridging two articles on the bill read, "Stimulus Offers Road to Retooling Social Policy."

Without hearings and without public debate, radical anti-faith, anti-family programs have been put in place with the signing of this bill. A few examples follow.

One of the most direct and insidious attacks on persons of faith is a provision that grants federal funds for the renovation of existing colleges and universities. The provision specifically denies access to those funds

if the facility being renovated is a religiously based or faith based institution, or if the facility being renovated simply allows religious worship to take place.

In order to qualify for the funding, schools would be forced to bar on-campus worship or even Bible study – a direct violation of federal law, which says that schools receiving federal financial assistance cannot limit access to facilities or discriminate against people of faith.

Senator Jim DeMint (R-South Carolina) discovered the provision and immediately proposed an amendment to kill it.

Said DeMint, "Democrats are looking for every opportunity to purge faith and prayer from the public square. This will empower

the ACLU with ambiguous laws that create liability for schools, universities, and student organizations. This is an attack on people of faith..."

His amendment failed.

Certainly one of the most controversial and difficult-to-sell aspects of President Obama's social agenda is his push for universal socialized health care. Through the "stimulus package" he has effortlessly taken a giant step toward that goal.

The bill first provides \$20.3 billion to accelerate adoption of a national medical database to electronically track the medical records of "every individual in the United States." It next allocates

\$1.1 billion for the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality to conduct “comparative effectiveness research,” the purpose of which is to evaluate the merits of different medical treatments to “determine the best practice for the treatment of a certain condition.” The National Coordinator of Health Information Technology then is charged with the responsibility of monitoring treatment to ensure that physicians are prescribing only the treatments that have been evaluated appropriate and cost-effective.

These provisions are identical to those advocated by former Senator Tom Daschle, Obama’s first pick to head the Department of Health and Human Services, in his 2008 manual, “Critical: What We Can Do About the Health-Care Crisis.” According to Daschle doctors must be forced to give up autonomy. Under the plan, every medical decision would be made by federal bureaucrats, not doctors, patients or families. Ultimately, the plan would apply not only to federally funded health care, but

to the private sector as well.

While on the one hand the health care plan outlined above limits every citizen’s health care to what a federal medical czar deems cost effective, on the other hand this bill ironically directs \$2.7 billion to the NIH for, among other things, embryonic stem cell research. Not only do the majority of Americans consider research requiring the death of human embryos morally objectionable, but in addition years of private research using embryonic stem cells have resulted in zero cures. Cost effectiveness would demand that available funds be channeled into research using adult stem cells – research that has a proven track record of life-saving cures.

Whereas public outcry prevented inclusion of some of the president’s most radical “family planning” (read: abortion promoting) programs, the bill passed still halts funding of abstinence education programs while directing \$1 billion to a new “Prevention and Wellness Fund,” which

would be available for education programs on sexually transmitted diseases. (Examples of recent government expenditures in STD prevention include funding for a transgender beauty pageant in San Francisco and an event called “Got Love? – Flirt/Date/Score.”)

President Obama would take the education of our children out of the hands of parents, local communities and even states. This bill takes a large leap toward federalization of the nation’s education system. Its \$150 billion, covering nearly every aspect of education, would more than double the Department of Education’s current budget. Private and religious schools, of course, are excluded.

Many consider President Obama’s environmental initiatives questionable from both a scientific and economic perspective and detrimental to our nation’s true energy independence. The bill passed funnels billions into those questionable programs.

## Anti-American

The controversial stimulus package rushed through the House and Senate and signed into law in Denver with great fanfare totals \$787 billion, slightly less than the two previous versions. When debt is added, the bill still totals in excess of \$1 trillion, a number that average Americans cannot truly comprehend. The version passed actually represents an increase in spending measures (\$505 billion), offset by a decrease in tax relief (\$282 billion).

It is particularly troubling that in the tax relief portion of the bill, small businesses are almost entirely left out. According to House Minority Leader John Boehner (R-Ohio), approximately one-third of one percent of the total bill — \$3 billion — is directed to tax relief for that sector of our economy that has been most effective in true job creation during the past two decades.

The balance of the spending

portions of the 1,073-page bill – that is, those portions not directly connected to anti-family social programs – still negatively affect all Americans. They are wasteful, special-interest spending programs, for which American families will be paying for generations to come through higher taxes and inflation.

On the very week that majority party legislators were meeting behind closed doors to ensure that their pet projects were not cut from the final version, President Obama told an audience in Elkhart, Indiana, “Understand, this bill does not have a single earmark in it.” Such a statement represents deceptive semantics, at best. The majority of the bill’s spending programs are pure pork – tailored to special interest and local projects that will result in the creation of few if any permanent jobs.

Just a few examples:

• **\$2 billion** for a clean-coal power

plant with specifications matching one in Mattoon, Illinois;

• **\$10 million** for urban canals;

• **\$2 billion** for manufacturing advanced batteries for hybrid cars;

• **\$255 million** for a polar icebreaker for the Coast Guard;

• **\$300 million** to buy new “green friendly” cars for federal employees;

• **\$1 billion** for ACORN-eligible block grants;

• **\$43.6 billion** directed to programs that the Office of Management and Budget has rated as “ineffective” or results not demonstrated.”

• **\$53 billion** to a “Stabilization Fund” to reward states that have spent irresponsibly and find themselves in serious debt;

• **\$30 million** for a “wetlands restoration” project to protect harvest mice in the San Francisco Bay area (House Speaker Nancy Pelosi’s very last-minute addition); – and

• Senator Harry Reid’s (D-Nevada) 11th hour addition, **\$8 billion** for a super train between Las Vegas and Los Angeles.

To his Indiana audience, President Obama also bragged, "The plan that we've put forward will save or create three million to four million jobs over the next two years." But his own budget office cautioned, "It should be understood that all of the estimates presented... are subject to significant margins of error." Global Insight estimates that the plan will create only 2.5 million jobs; Macroeconomic Advisers places the number at 2.3 million. And most of these are temporary jobs tied to specific projects. Experts estimate that the cost-per-job-created will be somewhere between \$229,000 and \$262,000. The CBO further warned that hundreds of billions of the expenditures authorized by the bill would not take place until 2011 and beyond.

## From Fear to Haste to Waste

In his inaugural address President Obama declared, "We have chosen hope over fear." But fear was his weapon of choice in campaigning for this bill. "A failure to act, and act now," he said, "will turn crisis into a catastrophe." And so gigantic spending projects worthy of weeks or months of serious study and debate were added to the massive bill behind closed doors and with little or no discussion.

After receiving the "emergency" measure on February 14, President Obama left it on his desk and headed off to Chicago for a leisurely Valentine's weekend. Even upon returning, he again postponed signing the bill until a prime-time op could be arranged outside of Washington.

On February 13 the *Wall Street Journal* reported that the federal agencies that will be responsible for implementing the bill's many programs simply do not have the contracting manpower to manage such an unprecedented explosion of spending. Many of the projects would require environmental impact studies, which alone would require five to eight years to complete under normal circumstances. It would not have been a "catastrophe" to take the time

necessary to properly review and debate such programs before voting on them.

Economists and political analysts alike are concluding that President Obama's urgency to pass this bill without debate is driven by disdain for our nation's exceptional free enterprise system. Writing in *National Review*, Rich Lowry pointed out that from 1983 to 2000, the size of federal government relative to our gross domestic product (GDP) actually declined from 23.5 percent to 18.4 percent. "Federal spending didn't shrink," he points out, "but it grew at a slower rate than the economy, providing more breathing room for the private sector."

Lowry continues, "It had bounced back to 20.9 percent last year, and could conceivably go as high as 28 percent this year. According to *Newsweek*, in 2010 total U.S. government spending will be 39.9 percent of GDP, only about eight percentage points below the average in the socialistic eurozone countries."

Conservative financial and political analysts warned that by the end of President Obama's first term our health and public education systems could be nationalized, and our nation could be effectively a socialist welfare state. They were ridiculed.

Church and para-church prophets warned that by the end

of President Obama's first term marriage and family in this nation would be redefined, the nation would be even more firmly entrenched in the holocaust of abortion, and those who express beliefs contrary to any of these outcomes would face legal persecution. They, too, were ridiculed.

Both the analysts and prophets appear to have been wrong – but only with respect to their time schedule. Even they could not have predicted how

effectively President Obama would take advantage of the nation's economic crisis to jumpstart all those goals.

## TAKE ACTION

For legislators to stand up against this bill, which is so destructive to the economic and moral fabric of our nation, meant subjecting themselves to criticism from and ostracism by their colleagues and to ridicule from the mainstream, liberal media.

# U.S. Back in the Business of Exporting Abortion

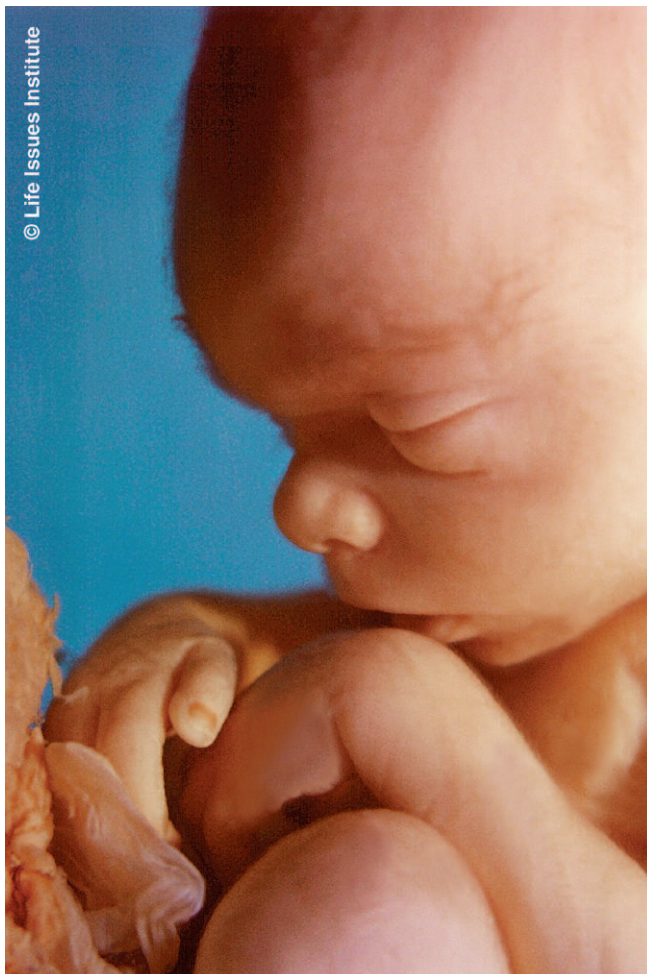
On January 23, President Barack Obama issued an executive order – the second of his brief administration – to rescind the Mexico City Policy.

The effect of the order was to take hundreds of millions of dollars out of the hands of family planning organizations in other countries that do not perform or promote abortions, and place them in the hands of organizations that promote abortion as a primary method of family planning and population control.

That effect is troubling in itself. Perhaps even more troubling, though, is what this order says about the value our president places on human life. Rescinding the Mexico City Policy confirms the emptiness of our newly elected president's pledge to work to reduce abortions and speaks in loud, clear tones of his determination to expand the holocaust of abortion not only nationally, but internationally as well.

## Background

The Mexico City Policy initially was implemented by President Reagan in 1984 at a United Nations' Population conference in Mexico City (thus the name). The purpose of the Reagan memorandum was to halt U.S. family planning dollars from being directed to foreign non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that perform abortions or



“actively promote” abortion as a method of family planning and population control in other countries. The policy was rescinded by President Clinton in 1993, but restored by President Bush on the first day of his first term.

It is important to note that the Mexico City Policy did not cut off assistance to foreign NGOs involved in family planning. It simply insured that the organizations receiving such funds were not in the business of performing, promoting or forcing abortion.

Forces promoting abortion as a means of population control have tagged the Mexico City Policy the “global gag rule,” a term that is deliberately misleading

and nonsensical. In fact, under the policy, organizations receiving U.S. family planning funds could still use them to provide referrals for abortion in cases of rape, incest or to protect the life of the mother. They could use them to treat injuries caused by abortions. They could even use them for post-abortion care. They simply could not use them to advocate or perform abortions.

## Clarification

If there was any doubt about President Obama's disregard for the life of the unborn and disdain for those who uphold the sanctity of all life, the statement that he released after

rescinding the Mexico City Policy surely erased that doubt.

After an awkward attempt to disguise his death sentence in the language of “empowering women and promoting global economic development,” President Obama concluded with this remark: “In addition, I look forward to working with Congress to restore U.S. financial support for the U.N. Population Fund (UNPF).”

At President Bush's insistence the United States has withheld funding of the UNPF primarily because of that group's support of the abusive, coercive abortion policies of China and other nations. And now our president “looks forward” to using our tax

# Change in Columbus

60% Decrease in Strip Clubs = Good News for Families

Columbus – It is one city in which all Ohioans take pride!

After all! It is our state capital, and home of the Ohio State Buckeyes!

*Money Magazine* recently rated our capital city the eighth best large city in the U.S. to inhabit. It's the 15th largest city in the U.S., and Greater Columbus has a population of over 1.7 million, making it the 32nd largest metropolitan area.

Residents of Columbus, however, don't think of their city in terms of its largeness. Columbus is the home of the Neighborhood Pride Initiative. Its residents strive to maintain a strong sense of family and community pride. It's a big city, yes, but one with a small town feeling.

For many years, unfortunately, one less-publicized but undeniable statistic has damaged the reputation of our capital city and has stood in the way – in the way not only of community pride, but of community and family safety as well: For a city of its size, Columbus historically has had more than its share of sexually oriented businesses.

And with sexually oriented businesses come the inevitable "adverse secondary effects" (as the U.S. Supreme Court dubbed them years ago): increased crime and decreased property values.

## Pride Returning

In 2004, shortly after joining CCV to head up its Columbus office, Director of Governmental

Affairs Barry Sheets conducted research into the number of businesses legally operating as sexually oriented businesses in Columbus. The numbers were staggering in all categories – adult book stores, massage parlors, escort services, even bath houses. The most shocking number, however, was in the category of nude or semi-nude strip clubs: **48 within the limits of the City of Columbus alone.**

Just recently, Sheets took another count. As of December 2008, there were only 19 such strip clubs operating in the City of Columbus. **A 60 percent reduction!**

That's good news – for all the men, women, children, families and communities of Columbus. It's good news for all Ohioans!

How did it happen? Each sex business that has ceased to operate during the past four years has its own set of circumstances. But three significant factors contributing to this positive change

can be clearly identified.

### Citizen concern!

During the past few years our *Citizens' Courier* has reported on several highly publicized Columbus strip club closings.

(To review, visit [CCV.org](http://CCV.org) and click on Change in Columbus.) In most cases, the investigations that led to these closings began when citizens voiced their concerns to local law enforcement.

**CPD!** When citizens complained, the Columbus Police Department responded. Their investigations frequently uncovered all the crimes so often associated with sex businesses – particularly prostitution and illegal drug sales. Often months of time-consuming undercover investigative work were necessary before clubs finally could be closed on public nuisance charges.

**CDA!** In the fall of 2007, after a five-year legislative battle, CCV was successful in working with state legislators to pass the Community Defense Act, which placed two important regulations on all sex businesses throughout

the state. Hours of operation were restricted, and physical contact between nude employees and patrons was prohibited. These straightforward statewide regulations have curtailed illegal activity and made it more difficult for these businesses to profit from it, while greatly facilitating the monitoring of sex businesses by local law enforcement officials.

Sound regulations; citizen concern; law enforcement: All three factors must be in place. And when they are, as the Columbus numbers prove, a community can change for the better.

### Your Action

If you live in a neighborhood of Columbus, or in any Ohio community still threatened by the presence of sexually oriented businesses, please realize that you might be the missing factor preventing positive change.

"It's what we call the "Power of One," says CCV's vice-president of public policy, David Miller, who authored a citizen-action handbook with that title, available as a download on CCV's Web site.

A sound law, the Community

Defense Act, *is* in place. Your community *is* served by a law enforcement agency. If your community and your family are suffering the adverse secondary effects of a sex business, contact your local police department and ask that they investigate to determine whether that business is operating in accordance with the two regulations of CDA.

Encourage your neighbors to do likewise.

Perhaps you have grown accustomed to the existence of a strip club or other sex business in your community. Perhaps you do not feel personally threatened by the secondary crimes associated with that business. Perhaps calling your local law enforcement officials places you out of your comfort zone.

If that description fits you,

please consider the message that all strip clubs send to our culture

and especially to our youth. First, strip clubs are built on the lie that women are objects, the primary function of which is the sexual satisfaction of men. And underlying that lie is an even more fundamental message: God's plan for our sexuality, the life-long, one-flesh relationship between one man and one woman, is not relevant in our culture.

Consider also the individual lives damaged by all strip clubs. The women trapped in a degrading, abusive business. The families dismantled because of a husband and father addicted to the false messages of strip clubs.

Consider those messages. Pray about those individuals and families. And then consider again making that call – and becoming the final factor necessary to positive change in your community.

### The President's Report

As educational and inspiring as Barton's keynote address will be, the focal point of CCV's Partnership Banquet, as always, will be the report delivered by CCV's president since 1991, Phil Burress.

"It's a little intimidating to share the podium with a captivating, engaging speaker like Barton," Burress admits, "but I still look forward to this one opportunity that we have each year to share with so many friends – face-to-face – the amazing victories God has made possible through their support during the past year."

"Equally important," says Burress, "will be laying out our

strategy for the challenging year ahead. Newly elected officials at the federal and state levels have made very clear their opposition and disregard for the moral values that we know are so important to the past and present of our nation and state. CCV has campaigns in place to counter those inevitable attacks. dollars to support such atrocities.

This blatant disregard for life shocked many of those who had believed the president's campaign rhetoric. A January 30 *USA Today*/Gallop poll revealed that the reversal of the Mexico City Policy was President Obama's most unpopular action to date. Sixty-five percent of Americans disapproved.

Negative reaction to the rescinding order extended beyond this country. Particularly telling was the reaction of leaders in less-developed countries that are the recipients of U.S. family planning funds.

Congresswoman Martha Lorena de Casco of Honduras expressed "deep regret and sorrow" that "one of President Obama's first decisions is to revoke the Mexico City Policy." She elaborated, "I interpret this action as a promotion of abortion and a threat to the national legislation of my country."

Senator Liliana Negre de Alonso, Vice-president of Argentina's Senate, had this to say: "We can't say we defend human rights if we don't defend the first human right, the Right to Life from conception to natural death. To use public funds to finance groups that promote abortion is not respecting the First Human Right – Life."

Christine Vollmer, president of the Caracas-based Latin American Alliance for the Family commented, "This is a horrible way for President Obama to begin to

relate with the United States' neighbors to the South."

Pro-abortion advocates, of course, heralded the reversal. Particularly jubilant was the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) – the world's largest and wealthiest abortion provider and a significant contributor to the Obama campaign. On their Web site, the IPPF lists their payoff expectations, and first on the list is "rescinding the global gag rule," followed by "restoring funding to the United Nations' Population Fund." President Obama is on track to meet and exceed those expectations.

In an interview with the BBC, an IPPF spokesperson stated that

under the Bush administration – thanks to the Mexico City Policy – the organization had lost more than \$100 million in funding.

Many pro-life organizations considered the Mexico City Policy the most effective pro-life policy of the Bush and Reagan administrations. Key to its effectiveness was the fact that the order did not reduce funding for family planning. It simply insured that those funds would not end up in the hands of militant organizations that would use them to expand abortion as a method of family planning and population control.

The timing of President Obama's rescinding order seemed to serve as an exclamation point: One day after the anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's deadly *Roe v. Wade* decision.

One day after millions had marched or met in memory of the 45 million innocent children deprived of life in this country, an order was signed that, if allowed to stand, will result in the deaths of millions in other countries as well.

## TAKE ACTION

Rep. Christopher Smith (R-NJ) has introduced a bill (H.R. 708) that would override the president's executive order. The bill has 62 co-sponsors, including Ohio Congressmen John Boehner, Jim Jordan, Robert Latta and Patrick Tiberi.

H.R. 708 has been assigned to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, with no hearings to date.
